Applicable Rule: 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart HHHHHH - National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP): Paint Stripping and Misc. Surface Coating Operations at Area Sources- Promulgated 1/9/08

Who is subject to this Rule?

This rule applies to paint stripping and miscellaneous surface coating operations that are area sources of hazardous air pollutants (HAP) emissions (the entire facility has the potential to emit <10 tons per year (tpy) of a single HAP or <25 tpy of a combination of HAP). Area sources that engage in any of the following activities are subject to this rule: Paint stripping operations that use methylene chloride (MeCl)-containing paint stripping formulations; Spray application of coatings to motor vehicles and mobile equipment; or Spray application of coatings to a plastic and/or metal substrate where the coatings contain compounds of chromium (Cr), lead (Pb), manganese (Mn), nickel (Ni), or cadmium (Cd).
